Each Friday evening, an older camper or counselor presents a sermon to share their thoughts of life at Camp Towanda. This past summer, Chandler Bolog, a 2nd generation camper and Camper Captain, reflected on her experience.

Good evening and Shabbat Shalom. Following in my dad's path by attending Towanda, camp has always been a significant part of my life. My dad was so young when he started camp, that he wasn't even able to read or write a letter. He envisioned those same plans for me. However, there was one minor obstacle. I had never been able to make it through a sleepover. I would get so upset, that I needed to go home.

My transition from scared and shy to the fun-loving camper I am today, was smooth thanks to the support from my summer parents, Mitch and Stephanie. They provided me with the love and opportunities, which made me realize overcoming my fear of being away from home was a challenge I was capable of taking. Mitch and Stephanie always make me feel comfortable, at home, and in addition they are my camp role models. They encouraged me to make new friends and be myself around them.

My dad always shares his stories about how he is still close with his camp friends from 30 years ago, but each day I spend at camp makes these stories more meaningful to me. Bob and Spiz were my dad's counselors; they speak on a regular basis year round and are close friends. His friendships have inspired me to stay in touch with my 28 group mates, best friends, and sisters. These girls have impacted my life in so many ways. From the perspective of a girl who has grown up with 2 brothers, it is a privilege to have 28 sisters who will always be there for me. For the youngest kids sitting in the front row, it is important to keep in mind that these relationships you make now will grow and live on forever. We should all remember that each day we have at camp is one day less than we will ever have. Cherish the memories, the bonds, the friends, the opportunities, and the experiences. Don't waste any time you have at camp, because in reality: these are the days, hours,

minutes, and seconds that we look forward to each year.

I've known Towanda through stories, as a place where lifelong friends and bonds are established, and where there are no hills and it never rains (funny one!), but most importantly... as my home. The friends I have made and the experiences I've had continue to shape me, and for that I am truly grateful.

To the Dorm of 2010: there's nothing I wouldn't give to be able to relive these past seven summers with you. And remember: "Anywhere I'll be these memories remain with me" (Dorm Alma Mater 2010).


