

GNE A HODT(IE)! The Everlasting Value of Camp

Michael "Hootie" Tesser is a 2nd generation camper/counselor. His Mom, Michele Taub, went to Towanda for many years as well. Hootie is currently entering his Junior year at Wharton and will be a Group Leader this coming summer for his Junior Boys, celebrating his "bar mitzvah" year at camp! He presented this sermon before the entire camp last summer.

In 1997, I arrived at camp as a quiet, shy 7-year old boy who went by the name Michael. Never in a million years would I have believed it if someone had told me that 12 summers later I would be on stage dressed as Sporty Spice teaching the entire camp a dance to "Spice Up Your Life" and going by the name Hootie. Ever since my first summer as a Jet, to my Club summer in 2004, to my current second summer as a counselor, I have noticed a major, overarching theme at camp – that *Towanda* is a place for people to defy expectations, break the norm, and become extraordinary. For over 11 summers, I have witnessed campers step out of their comfort zones to become unexpected leaders, energetic participants, and unbelievable campers. I've seen the guietest of campers cheer louder than all others during a Wayne County basketball game, an un-athletic underdog conquer the climbing wall with enthusiasm, and a Club boy who never before participated in Rope Burning to tough it out in getting to "build that fire higher, higher." I've seen countless stage-shy children sing, dance, act, jump, and scream in the Field House amphitheater, a Hootie, a Mini-Muffin, a Stick, a Brother Bear, and a Philly embrace their nicknames to the fullest, and polite campers eagerly lead cheers such as "Hey Dillies" and "Middies, Middies, Middies" in the dining hall when they would never even think twice about screaming at the dinner table at home. Camp Towanda is truly an amazing place.

13 summers ago I stepped off of Paramus Bus #1 not knowing what to expect and certainly not knowing that all that I've witnessed since then is possible. But I soon learned that it all is possible, which is why at the end of that same summer on the bus ride home I cried, clung to the seats, and pleaded for the bus counselors to take me back to camp while my parents waited for me with a welcomehome-hug in the rain. *Towanda* had me hooked right from the start. And thank God for that, or else I would have never learned that forming a tunnel for camper of the week winners to run through is a more fun way of saying "congratulations," that singing on the bus on trip days is a more fun way of passing the time, that chanting "let's get a little bit p-s-y-c-h-o" is a more fun way of saying "get excited," that banging on plates, cups, and tables in the mess hall is a more fun form of music, and that 26 boys singing to an entire Dorm is a more fun way of saying "we're sorry." As I said before, camp is truly an amazing place. Wear outrageously colored shoes. Shake your booty. Don't be shy. Enjoy it. Have fun with it. Trust me, camp is more fun that way. Step out of your comfort zone, embrace the unexpected, and don't simply go with the flow. Be who you want to be because there's only one place where you can easily get away with straying from the norm – it's here, at Towanda.




What We Hear From The Mansion Porch!!!


